

Attending Nursery School: Procedures for September



Entry will be accessed via the side gate by the main door. A member of staff will be by the gate to welcome you. We ask you to take your child into the garden.

Exit will be via the large gate in the garden, a member of staff will be there to guide you.

Settling children

Parents are not permitted in the nursery as we are trying to limit number of people inside the building, however we are aware that some children might struggle to settle. In the event a practitioner feels it would benefit the child for their parent to be inside, the parent will be asked to have their temperature taken and wash their hands with hand sanitiser. We would prefer not to have these measures in place, however we have to ensure we keep the whole school community safe.

Important Notice

Please ensure you are on time and stick to your groups allocated time. If you miss your allocated time, you will be asked to wait until there is an opportunity to let you in safely.



KEEP YOUR DISTANCE

Please remember to keep your distance from other children and adults-at least two metres. If we politely remind you, please do not be offended, we are just trying to keep everybody safe.

ONE ADULT

We are requesting that only one adult attend nursery with their child, and no siblings. We want to ensure drop off and collection times are as smooth and safe as possible-we can only achieve this by reducing the number of adults and children at one time.

No buggies, prams, scooters or bikes please.

PLEASE WORK WITH US

If your child, or any member of your household has symptoms, please stay away from the school. Also, please let us know. It is important we all work together to keep the school community safe.

Working in *partnership* with us



If a child develops a high temperature, or a continuous cough, we will be sending them home. We will follow government guidance. We will also be sending home any children that become unwell with any illness.

BRINGING IN THINGS FROM HOME

We request that children do not bring things in from home. Any toys brought in will be given back to parents to take home.

Permitted items are nappies and change of clothing. **We ask that a bag be brought in on the first day, and it remains at nursery until it needs replenishing.**
