

Early Years Pupil Premium Report for Academic Year 2020/2021

Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) was introduced to enhance and support children in order to improve their outcomes. Eligible children receive an extra 53p per funded hour (15-hour entitlement only). Funding is given to the nursery directly.

Number of children aged 3/4 on roll by summer term: 68 29%f cohort eligible for EYPP in summer term.

Therefore, we considered ways of developing areas of the nursery that would further support communication and language and personal and social development.
